Tallahassee United Futbol Club is a premier non-profit soccer organization that is pleased to offer a financial assistance program for soccer athletes who are in need of financial assistance in order to play soccer. This program is available to all youth, and a formal evaluation process will be initiated once the parents or guardians of the player complete and submit an application and supporting documentation. The amount of assistance is limited each year, and based on availability on a first-come, first-served basis. The Financial Assistance committee may have to make qualifying adjustments based on the availability of funds. Following this review, the applicant will be notified regarding their eligibility. Financial Assistance is granted based on financial need only, and is not based on playing ability. Tallahassee United Futbol Club Financial Assistance may cover club dues and uniform cost.

All Financial Assistance requests are strictly confidential. Information is for the sole purposes of helping the TUFCC Financial Assistance Committee determine financial assistance eligibility, and will not be shared with anyone except the TUFCC Board of Directors and the Club Registrar. In addition to the Financial Assistance Application, please submit a photocopy of the front page of the parent or guardian's most recent paycheck stub, and any additional money parent or guardian is receiving for care of child requesting aid. **Please remember to white out any social security numbers.** Please return the completed application and supporting documentation to you current coach or mail to:

Expectations:

- 1) Families receiving financial assistance are required to volunteer 10 hours for the club. The player or player's parent(s)/guardian will work in the club at some level as a trade-off for receiving Financial Assistance. Volunteer hours will be logged. Unusual circumstances will be evaluated on an individual basis, and exemptions granted based on Financial Assistance/Scholarship Committee approval. It is our intention for every child who wants to play soccer to be able to play, and at the same time secure the continued financial resources to do so.
- 2) Players receiving financial assistance are required to complete the entire year with their respective team. Failure to complete the year will result in repayment of financial assistance, denial of future financial assistance and/or denial of player release from club.

Types of Financial Assistance:

Financial Assistance — Financial Assistance covers club dues, registration fees and uniform expense. Assistance may range from 25% to 100% of the fees/dues based on need-based eligibility and available financial aid funds.

Please note that Financial Assistance provided by the club does NOT cover Registration, travel expenses, additional team requested team training other than scheduled, or other expenses that may be incurred playing soccer. Each player is responsible for their share of team expenses and their own travel expenses. Contact your team manager for an estimate of these expenses
